Club Registration Policy

The following document outlines the policy for accepting and making payments towards our annual registration fees for players registered with the club.

What Is the Registration Fee

Every season, a registration fee of £180 is requested from all registered players. This fee covers the cost of kits, training facilities, equipment and matchday facilities. As a club we rely on these fees to ensure the smooth running of the club.

When is the registration fee due?

The registration fee is due from the 1st of July every year, and can be paid in full at this time, or you can opt to pay your fees over 6 months.

If you join later in the year, you will be able to take 6 months to make your payments, and any registrations after January of that season will be calculated at a lower price.

Where should the registration fee be paid to?

Paying in instalments

If you decide to pay in instalments, the default due dates for each payment will be on the 1st of the month, so for instance, if you register on the 1st July, payments should be received on the 1st of every month up to and including the 1st December.

If a player registers after the 1st July, their initial payment will be required upon registration, with the remaining payments due on the 1st of the month for the following 5 months.

We would recommend that if you are paying in instalments, you set up a standing order to the account above for the duration of the payment period to ensure that the money is sent on time.

Example: A player registers on the 25th of July. Initial payment of £30 is due immediately, followed by 5 payments of £30 due on the 1st of each month, beginning on the 1st of August.

Half-Season Registration

If a player registers after January of a given season, they will only be required to pay half of the cost of registration (£90). This fee can be paid over 3 months with an initial payment of £30, and then a further £30 payment on the 1st of the following 2 months.

Overdue payments

If you are paying in instalments, and a payment is late (ie not received on the 1st of the month as agreed), the registered player will not be permitted to play for their team until the payment is received. If payments continue to not be received, the club may choose to terminate the player registration and ask the player to leave the club

Difficulty making payments

If you are having any difficulty making payments, please speak to either the treasurer or our welfare officer. We may be able to offer a longer payment period, or different payment dates
